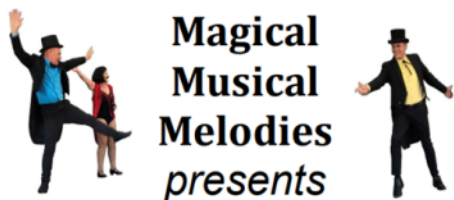

“Rest in the Midst of Struggle”

GENESIS 24:34-38; ROMANS 7:15-25a; MATTHEW 11:16-19,25-30 (NIV)

These readings speak to the deep tension between human weakness and divine faithfulness.

GENESIS 24:34-38

The servant of Abraham recounts how he was sent on a mission that required complete trust in God's guidance. He did not rely on his own cleverness alone, but on obedience and faith that God had already prepared the way. His story reminds us that when we faithfully carry out what God asks, even uncertain paths can unfold with clarity.

ROMANS 7:15-25a

Paul opens his heart in a deeply honest way: *“I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate.”* This is the human condition - struggling between the desire for good and the pull of sin. Paul's words reassure us that inner conflict does not mean we are failing; rather, it reveals our awareness and longing for God's grace. Our weakness is not the end of the story.

MATTHEW 11:16-19, 25-30

Jesus responds with both lament and invitation. He points out how people resist truth no matter how it is presented, yet He turns to the humble and says: *“Come to me... and I will give you rest.”* This is the answer to the struggle Paul describes and the trust lived by Abraham's servant. Jesus does not demand perfection; He offers *rest, relationship, and a lighter burden.*

These three readings show us a journey:

- *Genesis* ~ Trusting God in our mission.
- *Romans* ~ Struggling honestly with our limitations.
- *Matthew* ~ Finding rest and renewal in Christ.

We are not asked to be flawless, but to be faithful. Even when we feel divided inside or unsure of the path ahead, Jesus invites us to come as we are.

In Him, our striving finds peace, and our weakness becomes a place where grace can work.
